Per your recent telephone conversation with Charles Horn, it is understood that all polychlorinated biphenyl related manufacturing ceased on May 1, 1972. Your plant may, therefore, discontinue monthly monitoring of polychlorinated biphenyl losses to Snows Creek. Officials of the Environmental Protection Agency have been consulted and have indicated their agreement with this office.

Should you return to this process in the future, please advise, so that the monitoring program may be reinstated.
