Dear George:

We have somewhat improved our batting average since my letter to you of February 13, 1974. The box score now stands as follows for the Monsanto plants.

As I recall, last March I sent you copies of the death certificates for the 11 deaths at Indian Orchard. (The 5 escapees whom we recently found turned out to be alive.) I am enclosing copies of the death certificates for the 5 deaths at Texas City.

The 6 missing men seem to be unfindable either by us or by the Social Security Administration, so I suppose we'll have to give up on them, unless the Internal Revenue Service is willing to do for us what they did for our former President.

Our accounting department is sending an invoice separately.
